Drawing Now: An Introduction to Contemporary Drawing - with Zoë Nash

A basic kit of materials to get you up and going is listed here. Specialist art shops are the best option and will provide student discounts if you mention that you are attending the school. The stores we recommend are:

- Takapuna Art Supplies, Takapuna

Materials required:

- A range of pencils to include HB, 4B, 8B
- Willow charcoal, compressed charcoal
- 2 graphite pencils or sticks (of differing weights)
- Indian ink
- Round, pointed brush, approximate size 12
- Flat brush (around 4cm wide)
- Acrylic paints: black, white, (other colours if desired)
- PVA glue
- Rags and sponges assorted
- Jars or old tins for mixing ink x2
- An old toothbrush, drinking straws and skewers
- Masking tape and/or pins
- Fixative spray

This list is a general guide only. As the course progresses, students will be encouraged to source their own found surfaces, media and to research and plan their self-directed project.
